Application of Pardon

County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. N. Rolapp presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five and Two Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable X A. B. Fays prosecuted the case.
