Application for Parole

To the Honorable Board of Pardons

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Second day of May
A. D. 1903, at Provo City County of Utah
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable John F. Chidester presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Seven years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable A. C. Hatch prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joseph Davis
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Davis

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except as above stated.
