Application of John H. Cummings

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault with intent to commit Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of July A. D. 1909, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five (5) Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Scofield prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John H. Cummings I was convicted under the name of J. H. Cummings

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: W. O. Rose

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
