Application of Fred S. Graves

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of March A. D. 1915, at Price Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. W. Cheney prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Fred Samuel Graves I was convicted under the name of Fred Graves

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Bertha Wilson & Mary Brown

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
