Application of Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Arson

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 20 day of March A. D. 1913, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake City and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. C. Loofbourn presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One year to state Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Loofbourn prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank Monroe Scott I was convicted under the name of Frank Scott

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Carl Carl Scott

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this charge of Arson
