Application of James Saines #4756

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23th, day of September, A. D. 1926, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 1 to 10 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Saines I was convicted under the name of James Saines

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
