I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of December
A. D. 1925, at Boole County of Boole
and State of Utah, in the third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of
from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Prior P. Baird
I was convicted under the name of Prior Baird

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: W. B. Snider

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the present
one.
