Application of Frank James No. 5014

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of April A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A.A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank James I was convicted under the name of Frank James
