To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

Commutation to life imprisonment

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a _____ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am ~~serving a term of imprisonment in~~ *Confined in the State Prison awaiting execution*
under conviction and sentence on a charge of *Murder in the First Degree*

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the *20th* day of *February*
A. D. *1907*, at *Salt Lake City* County of *Salt Lake*
and State of Utah, in *the Third Judicial District* court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable *George G. Armstrong* presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to *be shot until dead on the 19th day of*
February 1907
and thereafter was imprisoned in the *State Penitentiary*

Fourth—Honorable *Frederick C. Loofbourou* prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is *Anthony J. Day*
I was convicted under the name of *A. J. Day*

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except *the above crime*
