Application of GEORGE PURKES

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of assault with intent to rape

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 07th day of October A. D. 1911, at Kanab County of Uintah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. L. HOWAN presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to the State Penitentiary for an indefinite period of time and thereafter was imprisoned in the said State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable J. J. Leonard prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George Purkes I was convicted under the name of George Purkes

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No other persons

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
