To the Honorable Board of Pardons

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah States Prison,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglar in the first degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the tenth day of February
A. D. 1906, at Ogden Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second district court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah States Prison
since Feb. 10. 1906

Fourth—Honorable Mr. Halberson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Eugene Bryant
I was convicted under the name of Eugene Bryant

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
