Application of James O'Connell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Committee~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of November A. D. 1907, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the 3rd Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Gen. G. Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of 3 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. O. Spaffour prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Dan P. O'Connell I was convicted under the name of James O'Connell

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
