Application for Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons
of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the state prison,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of illegal voting at a city election

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of January
A. D. 1904, at Manti County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in the District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jacob Johnson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve a term of six months
in the state prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the state prison

Fourth—Honorable Wm D. Livingston prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Andrew Mary
I was convicted under the name of Andrew Mary

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for
which I am now imprisoned.
