Application of John Scott

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Barual Knowledge

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. A. D. 1914, at Vernal County of Uinta Co. and State of Utah, in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to from 6 mo. to 5 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Mr. Donald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Parkson Scott I was convicted under the name of John Scott

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except before.
