Application of Robert A. Dean

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of September A. D. 1912, at Vernal County of Uinta and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. M. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Robert Alexander Dean I was convicted under the name of Robert A. Dean
