Application of Harry Shaffer

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Carried knowledge

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of January A. D. 1915, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. S. Petcher presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve from one to five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Hathemood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Harry Shaffer I was convicted under the name of Harry Shaffer

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
