Application of Chas. La Mars

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of January A. D. 1914, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid; Honorable Judge M. L. Kitchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Two years and six months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. C. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Chas. D. Myers. I was convicted under the name of Chas. La Mars.
