Application of George W^m Ashby

1794

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commute and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of February A. D. 1905, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. H. Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Eight (8) years imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable H. C. Loufferow prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George Williams Ashby I was convicted under the name of George Williams

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except This one
