Application of John Fredrick Hillyard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of Adultery.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of November A. D. 1914, at Logan County of Cache and State of Utah, in 1st District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Ball presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence (Judge's recommendation four months) and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary.

Fourth—Honorable Roy D. Thatcher prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Fredrick Hillyard I was convicted under the name of " " "

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
