Application of Marcus H. Petersen

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Seventh day of February A. D. 1907 at Logan, County of Cache, and State of Utah, in Dist. Court, 1st Judicial Dist. court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. Mangham, Judge presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Term One Year and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Fred J. Holton prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Marcus H. Petersen I was convicted under the name of Marcus H. Petersen,

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry Crosswell, Mart. Larsen.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
