Application of Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Fornication

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of July A. D. 1913, at Provo City, Utah County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One year in the State Prison

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on the 10th day of July, 1913

Fourth—Honorable Layman McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Clifton Nicholas Andrew I was convicted under the name of Clifton Andrew

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
