I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 2^d degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of January A. D. 1910, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3^d Jud. Dist court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. C. Lamborn prosecuted the case.
