I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary to Papers

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of November
A. D. 1901, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the 2nd Judicial Dist. court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry H. Palapp presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five (5) Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable A. B. Hayes prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Clarke
I was convicted under the name of Paul

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except as above stated
