First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of assault with deadly weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of Sept
A. D. 1912, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Loghounow presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Mr Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Winfield Wood
