Application of John M. Duke

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary in the second degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of January A. D. 1911, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in The First Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Maughan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve one year

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable C. Call prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Morgan Duke

I was convicted under the name of John Morgan Duke

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am now under sentence
