Application for Pardon.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF PARDONS OF THE STATE OF UTAH:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:--

First. That I am now serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison, under conviction and sentence on a charge of adultery committed with Ellen Bowman at Mt. Pleasant, Sanpete county, Utah.

Second. I was convicted and sentenced on the 15 day of September, A.D. 1908, at Manti, county of Sanpete, and state of Utah, in the district court, in and for the county and state aforesaid, Honorable Ferdinand Ericksen, presiding.

Third. I was sentenced to imprisonment for a term of eight months and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth. Honorable F.E. Woods, District Attorney, prosecuted the case.

Fifth. My true name, is John Zabriskie; I was convicted under the name of John Zabriskie.

Sixth. The names of the persons charged to have been connected with the offense are as follows:
Ellen Bowman, of Mt. Pleasant, Utah, is the name of the person with whom the offense was committed, but she was not complained against or arrested.

Seventh. I have never been convicted of any offense except as herein stated.
