Application of A. B. Walton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of embezzlement

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of July A. D. 1911, at Tooele City County of Tooele and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve one year

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Arthur B. Walton

I was convicted under the name of A. B. Walton

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

S. J. Shafer and George N. Higgs

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except above
