First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the States Prison of Utah under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of March A. D. 1909, at Ogden County of Heber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. H. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Three years hard labour in the Utah States Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the States Prison of Utah on the 22 day of March 1909 and have been a model prisoner with nothing against me

Fourth—Honorable Nathan J. Harris prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George Matthew Shields I was convicted under the name of George Fitzgerald
