First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Attempt Extortion

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of May A. D. 1911, at Fillmore City County of Millard and State of Utah, in The Fifth Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One year and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable E. Ryan prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William P. Vestal I was convicted under the name of " " "
