Application of John Hamm

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Davis County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of having on hand large quantities of liquors

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of Feb. A. D. 1912, at Bountiful County of Davis and State of Utah, in Bountiful City Justice's court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable P. P. Willey presiding.
