Application of John J. Alexander

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault with a deadly weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of Oct. A. D. 1910, at Pocatello, Carbon County of Utah, in 7th Judge Simons Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 5 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Director Fred Woods prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John J. Alexander I was convicted under the name of John J. Alexander

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except none
