Application of Ambrose Dunsellon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of October A. D. 1909, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Three Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. C. Soule prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Ambrose Dunsellon I was convicted under the name of Ambrose Dunsellon

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Seven or Eight (8) years imprisonment in Salt Lake County on the charge of House Burglary
