Application of Wm J. Chivell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a remission of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Tenth day of March A. D. 1909, at Paris County of Utah and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. O. Barth presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Two and one-half years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Thomas Cliff prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William John Chivell
I was convicted under the name of William J. Chivell

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above mentioned
