Application of Frank Leonard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Restoration of credits} and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of October A. D. 1902, at Picea, County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District, court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judas Joubert Johnson, presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 10 yrs, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable Mr Livingston, prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank Leonard, I was convicted under the name of Frank Leonard.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Morris.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery & Burglary 18 months for Forgery, 3 yrs for Burglary, in Deer Lodge Prison, Montana.
