Your letter of the 22d instant reached me in due time. You say that Attorney General Barnes advises you that the reason the Board cannot act upon your application for clemency is that I have not filed a recommendation in your case. You were sentenced to a definite term, as provided in the laws of the State of Utah, and the fact that no recommendation, other than this sentence by the Court, has been made has nothing whatever to do with the power of the Board to act upon your application. The responsibility in all these matters is with the Board and not with the judge or the court which imposes the sentence.
