Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of December A. D. 1910, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the The Utah Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable F. C. Loofbrow prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Reitz I was convicted under the name of John King
