I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of April A. D. 1914, at Provo, County of Utah and State of Utah, in 6 Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve from three to twenty years in Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. H. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Gardner I was convicted under the name of John Gardner

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Arthur Rowley, Earl Fairchild

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
