To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary in the third degree.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Seventeenth day of May A. D. 1911, at Manti County of San Pete and State of Utah, in The Seventh Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve six months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable F. B. Woods prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Lewis William Lund. I was convicted under the name of Lewis William Lund.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

James A. Lund

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am serving sentence.
