Application of Jean Devosse No. 4305

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of November A. D. 1923, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in The Sixth district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Erickson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty (1 to 20) years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Nephi J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Jeanne Jeanne Trisoddy I was convicted under the name of Jean Devosse

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Robert Clark

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on prison records
