Application of Edward Killee

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October A. D. 1907, at Castle Dale County of Emery and State of Utah, in Seventh District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Erickson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Six months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. C. Woods prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edward Killee. I was convicted under the name of Edward Killee.
