Application of William J O'Leary

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March A. D. 1907, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in District Ct. (3<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Dist.) Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. G. Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to fifteen years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Loopfrow prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Mr Joseph O'Leary I was convicted under the name of Mr Joseph O'Leary

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Mike McCabe - Mr. Lynch and Mr. Ward (first names not remembered)

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense, except that of robbery as above charged. This is my only conviction
