Application of Glenn Gleason

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

Commutation of Sentence

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a/ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Attempt to Commit Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of January A. D. 1914., at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five Years, the judge of the trial court recommending that I be "pardoned at a reasonably early date." and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George Edward Goulet

I was convicted under the name of Glenn Gleason

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Leo J. Cornelius

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the aforementioned.
