I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon or commutation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of burglary.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February
A. D. 1902, at Ogden city County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the 2nd Judicial Dist. court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. H. Rolapp presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to three (3) years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for a
period of one year and fifteen months.

Fourth—Honorable A. B. Hayes prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is James Broyles
I was convicted under the name of James Broyles.
