Application of Parley Galloway.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th, day of September A. D. 1912, at Vernal County of Uintah and State of Utah, in Fourth District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. E. Booth, presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One (1) Year, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable Harvey Cluff, prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Parley Galloway, I was convicted under the name of Parley Galloway.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except The above.
