Application of Thomas Inlay

To the Honorable Board of Pardons
of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of November
A. D. 1903, at Parangatch County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in the 6th District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. F. Chidester presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to two & one half (2 1/2)
years in the Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Joseph Erickson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas Inlay
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Inlay

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: Not any

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except for the above
mentioned
