Application of George Daniels No. 6030

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a PARDON and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of attempted 2nd degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of January A. D. 1933, at Beaver County of Beaver and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six Mo. to Two years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ellis F. Rickett prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald Daniel Morris I was convicted under the name of George Daniels.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Moore

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
