Application of Frank Greig

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary in the 2nd degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of June A. D. 1907, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Eighteen months imprisonment with hard labor in the State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Sorenson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank Greig
I was convicted under the name of Frank Greig

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the present.
