Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of January A. D. 1908, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in the 2nd Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to one year's imprisonment in the State Prison Salt Lake City and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable G. A. Yalverson prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Jacob L. Cochran
