Application of Pardon

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of Dec
A. D. 1908, at Ogden County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in 7th District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Booth, presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 15 months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth—Honorable Mr. O'Connell prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Alfred H. Kottenstein
I was convicted under the name of Alfred H. Kottenstein

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
