

Salt Lake City, Utah, June 24th 1911

Application of Edmond Mason

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of having carnal knowledge of a female under 18 years

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of January A. D. 1911, at Coalville County of Summit and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of one year and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Frederick L. Coffman prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edmond Mason I was convicted under the name of Edmond Mason

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except in my life time except the above I entered a Plea of Guilty in this case when called on to plead on January 16th 1911
